We believe in a healthier Wales where people get the health and social care services, they need in a way that works the best for them During our first month as Llais, in our West Wales region, Llais staff met with Social Care Directors and other senior staff in all three Counties for an introductory meeting informing them of our role.



Llais staff also met with Carmarthenshire & Pembrokeshire Mental Health forum, again this was an introductory meeting to explain the role of Llais.

We have met with some local politicians who are Members of the Senedd, again raising awareness of Llais and listening to their concerns and what they are hearing from their constituents about health and social care.


Llais volunteers and staff attended several public consultation events about the Hywel Dda University Health Board land selection options for the proposed new hospital during April and May. These events were held across the three counties of Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion and Pembrokeshire in the towns and villages of:

Llandybie, Llandovery, Carmarthen, Llanelli, Cardigan, Aberystwyth, St Clears, Whitland, Milford Haven, Goodwick



There were 3 options available, these had been developed following an option appraisal process and meant that 2 sites in Whitland and 1 site in St Clears were being considered

I went to Glangwili A&E with my 2 year at night, the waiting area was horrendous. There was no separate area for children. There were poorly people waiting to be seen, I did not want my child to see all that. There should be a separate area for children
