Llais attended many events during September and October, one of which was the Carmarthenshire Carers Forum. Staff gave a talk to carers regarding Llais and its work, and the carers in turn fed their concerns back to the staff. The main concerns were listed as:

- GP access
- Delay in diagnosis of Autism / lack of support
- Dental services /access to NHS dentists
- Poor communication within NHS and Social Services

Another event we attended was hosted by the Bevan Commission and was called "Public conversations on the challenges of health and care services".

Some of the public that we met stated that:



"Some people stated that more needed to be done to keep people out of hospital"

The Bevan commission will be writing a full report and publishing on their website.

People are also completing our survey on their experience in Health and Social Care, here are some quotes from the public:



Staff have been visiting care homes within Pembrokeshire,

Carmarthenshire and Ceredigion and introducing themselves to the care home managers while talking about Llais. We are also undertaking these visits in the months of November and December.

We visited South Pembrokeshire Hospital to speak to patients who are receiving care in the hospital setting; most people were happy about their care and found the nurses caring - a full report will be published in the next few weeks.



What's coming up?

Llais West Wales Engagement team have been busy booking events where we can go and meet people to hear their views on health and social care.

We will be at Tumble Hall on the 8th November to listen to the public who will be affected by the changes to GP services in Tumble and Crosshands doctors surgery.

We will be presenting to Pembrokeshire County Council Health and Social Care Committee on the 9th November 2023.

We have planned to visit care homes in the Carmarthenshire area on 24th November 2023.

Llais will also be in attendance at Laugharne Memorial Hall on the 28th November 2023 listening to the public on the proposed changes to the Laugharne GP branch surgery .
