We know how much Llanidloes Hospital means to the community — and that recent temporary changes to services have raised concerns for many of you.

At **Llais,** our role is to listen to you and speak up on your behalf. That's why we've taken your concerns directly to Powys Teaching Health Board and asked them for answers. Here's what we've been told — and what we're doing next:

What's Happening?

1. How are people being kept informed?

The Health Board has shared updates on their website and say they are using email alerts and local networks. They also plan to discuss the evaluation of the current changes at their **Board meeting in July**.

2. Are there new changes coming?

Not yet. The "Better Together" programme is currently gathering views on local health services – no decisions have been made. You can take part until **25 May** via your local council, library, or online.

3. What about people waiting longer for care?

We've been told the Health Board is working with NHS England providers to improve support for people on waiting lists. More updates are expected in June.



4. What services are still available at Llanidloes Hospital? You can find a list of current services on the Health Board's website.

- Listen to local people we're out in your communities and want to hear your views.
- Challenge decision-makers we've asked for clearer communication and more inclusive engagement.
