


# WHAT WE HEARD IN NEWTOWN

### What is this report about?



In April 2025, Llais Powys visited the Newtown area to talk to people about their experiences with health and social care.





We spoke to people who use services in **Wales** and **England**.





We talked to people in different ways:

At community group meetings

At drop-in sessions

At GP surgeries

Through **paper** and **online** surveys.

## What people told us



#### **Good things**

Kind and helpful staff like GP's, nurses, and ambulance crews.



**Ladywell Surgery** was praised for mental health support.

## Not so good GP Appointments



Hard to get non-urgent appointments.



Long waiting times for routine care.



Not seeing the same doctor.

#### **Mental Health**



Hard to get help unless in a crisis.



Not enough support for young people





People lost their place with NHS dentists but did not know why.



Older people and families most affected

#### Hospitals



Some hospitals, like Bronglais, gave good care.



Other hospitals had problems like:

Poor discharge planning.



Poor cleanliness and dignity.



Problems sharing records between Wales and England.

#### **Transport and Access**



Poor public transport.



Not enough parking spaces for disabled people at the medical centre.



People had to travel far for medicines.

# What People want to talk to the Health Board and Local Council about



#### **GP Services**

Help with Mental Health: People want support if they feel anxious, sad or stressed.




**Listening to Patients:** People want to say how they feel about health services and be heard.



**Better Teamwork:** Services (like GP's, hospitals, mental health teams) need to work together.



**Easier Appointments:** People want to get to appointments easily when they need them.



#### **Dental Services**


**Losing Your Dentist:** People want to know why they are taken off the dentist list.



Help for People Who Struggle: Some people find it hard to go to the dentist. They need more help.



Clear Information: People want to know what dental care they can get and how to get it.



#### Hospitals

#### **Hospitals Working Together:**

Hospitals in different towns should share information and work as a team.



#### Respect and Involvement:

People want to be treated kindly and be part of decisions about their care.





#### **Transport and Access**

**Transport:** People need better transport to get to doctors and hospitals.



#### **Listening to Parents and Carers:**

People want to share their stories and ideas to help improve services.
